Digital Citizenship

We are very proud of the new technology our students have been provided. Digital instruction is a large part of student learning. Below are ways to maintain proper care of these devices.

- · Keep food and drink away
- Keep your hands clean
- Do not remove any identification labels
- Do not apply stickers or skins to the device
- Avoid leaving your device in a car
- Avoid excessive heat or cold
- Charge the battery fully each night
- Close the lid when not in use
- Do not carry the device by the screen
- Do not place on a bed, pillow or other soft material, this may cause it to overheat
- Unplug your device during a storm
- Be careful with the charger, do not step on it or yank to remove it
- Do not stack things on top of your device
- Back up your work!
