Understanding Volume

ONLY three dimensional figures can be measured for volume, which is the space on the inside if the figure is hollow and can be filled. We have learned **TWO** ways to measure it.

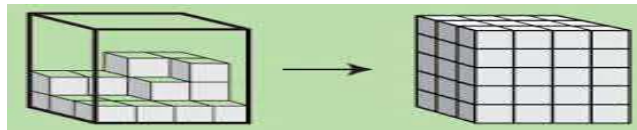
1. COUNTING UNIT CUBES
2. **VERIFYING** it by using the formula $V = \text{length} \times \text{width} \times \text{height}$

Vocabulary

Unit cube- a cube with a side length of 1 unit x 1 unit x 1 unit which equals one **cubic unit/ unit cubed**

Unit- anything you measure with (in., ft., cm., etc.)

Measurement- the size, length, or amount of something
