Reading: We will be introducing folktales this week. RI.2.1 and RL.2.1- Ask and answer such questions as who, what, where, when, and how to demonstrate understanding of key details in a text.

Resources: Use articles from Readworks.org to work on to find evidence to answer questions. Work on IStation.

Writing: W.2.2 Write informative/explanatory texts in which they introduce a topic, use facts and definitions to develop points, and provide a concluding statement or section.

Math: 2.NBT.2 Count within 1000; skip-count by 5s, 10s, and 100s starting at any number ending in 5 or 0. Skip-count by 10s and 100s starting at any number. 3.NBT.8 Mentally add 10 or 100 to a given number 100-900, and mentally subtract 10 or 100 from a given number 100-900.

Resources: Jam sessions on TenMarks, practice spelling numbers eleven through twenty, comparing numbers war (draw two cards each and decide which is greater, whoever's wins the card.)
